Romania, located in southeastern Europe, is a country with a rich history, stunning landscapes, and a vibrant culture. Romania covers an area of 238,391 km2, compared it is somewhat smaller than the United Kingdom (242,900 km2), or slightly smaller than the U.S. state of Oregon. Romania has a population of 19.8 million people (2015), capital and largest city is Bucharest, with a population of 2 million people.

Romania joined NATO in 2004 and the EU in 2007. Now it's a Schengen member state. Romania's strategic location along the Black Sea and its commitment to strong transatlantic relations have made it a key partner for both the EU and the United States in the region

#### **EU Membership**:

Joining: Romania became an EU member state on January 1, 2007. Since then, it has actively participated in EU institutions and decision-making processes. The official currency of Romania is the Romanian Leu (RON). The country has committed to adopting the euro once it fulfills the necessary conditions. Schengen Member: Romania is also a member of the Schengen area, which means that air and sea border controls have been lifted as of March 31, 2024.

#### **Geography and Landscape**

Carpathian Mountains: The Carpathians dominate the central part of Romania, offering breathtaking views, lush forests, and opportunities for outdoor adventures. Black Sea Coastline: Romania has a small but picturesque coastline along the Black Sea, providing sandy beaches and a pleasant climate.


